Giovanni C. Migliaccio holds a P. D. Koon Endowed Professorship in Construction Management with the Department of Construction Management at the University of Washington (UW), Seattle; he also serves as the Executive Director of the Center for Education and Research in Construction (CERC), and the co-director of the Safety and Health Advancement through Research and Education (SHARE) and Project Delivery and Management (PDM) Labs. He holds a M.S. and a Ph.D. in Civil Engineering from the University of Texas at Austin and a master-level degree from Politecnico di Bari in Italy. At UW, Giovanni is active in all three pillars of academic life, including service to the university and the industry, teaching, and research. His areas of specialization and research include: (1) Innovative procurement, contracting, subcontracting and delivery practices for construction projects; (2) Sustainable management of construction workforce with focus on ergonomics, human performance, and physiological demand of construction work; (3) Sustainable management of the built environment; (4) Project management; (5) Innovative construction engineering and management education. His scholarly work is based on a combination of methods, including qualitative and quantitative data collection and analysis. Giovanni has also worked or consulted for various organizations, including the World Bank, PCL Construction, Nortel Networks, Nokia Networks, and IPSE 2000.
